

[i] Calls for Proposals



• Since 2016, a total of **31 operations** [including Technical Assistance] have been selected for co-financing, out of which 26 operations are fully completed.

• One restricted call for project proposals was issued to the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture (DFA) on 29 September 2023, on the basis of Article 68(3) of the EMFF Regulation (EU) No. 508/2014 with regards to the **Ukraine Aid Scheme**.

Ukraine Aid Scheme:

A compensation scheme to alleviate the impact of additional operational costs incurred by fishers, as a result of the market disruption caused by Russia's act of aggression against Ukraine.

- An application form was submitted by the DFA on 16 October 2023 and was evaluated by the Project Selection Committee on 24 October 2023.
- The Grant Award Letter was issued by the Managing Authority on 6 November 2023.













• Following circulation of the draft Annual Implementation Report (reporting year 2022), which was accepted by the Monitoring Committee via written procedure, the report was submitted to the European Commission on 30th May 2023 and was subsequently found admissible by the Commission on 13th June 2023.

Statement of Expenditures undertaken in 2022 and 2023 – Accounting Year 1st July 2022 – 30th June 2023

3 SOEs completed until December 2022 for accounting year ending 30th June 2023

- 1 payment application amounting to €868,065.61 (EU Share) was submitted to EC on 21st November 2022
- 1 payment application amounting to €1,060,349.91 (EU Share) was submitted to EC on 27th December 2022
- 1 payment application amounting to €897,832.03 (EU Share) was submitted on 25th July 2023
- 71 documentary OTS checks were conducted for accounting year 1st July 2022 30th June 2023.



State of Play: OP Allocation









Progress towards EMFF Performance Framework Output Targets




■ Committed Operations as at October 2023

Update on OP Commitments

- As at today, EUR 30,643,426.69 (total public eligible) were committed out of the total contribution of EUR 29,168,694.33 (including Technical Assistance). This amounts to circa 105.05% of total public eligible allocated Funds (overcommitted).



Forecast of N+3

• N+ 3 target for 2023: As at 1st January 2023, n+3 target for Allocation Year 2020 is €6.38m. Being the Final Accounting Year, initial and annual prefinancing must be cleared against certified expenditure to be declared at the latest, in the Final Application for Payment to be submitted by the 31st July 2024. The expenditure certified during the current financial year (2022-2023) amounts to €0.9m (EU share), thus the amount of €5.48m in EU funds remain to be certified in the current and final accounting year to absorb 100% of Malta's EMFF allocation.



[iv] Communication & Publicity Activities



Publicity obligation

The Communications Unit is currently focusing on a specific funding programme each week. The fisheries sector was the #focusoftheweek during a particular week in August.

[v] EMFF / EMFAF Database System



- The EMFF Database was launched in year 2016, whilst the Structural Funds Database (SFD), which is a horizontal system that caters for all funds, including EMFAF, was launched in 2023;
- So far the EMFF Database includes 48 active users and 1694 claims for payment have been processed. These include Technical Assistance;
- Further updates on both systems are envisaged.
